Service Line Material Information

Service line material can be identified by the following characteristics:

- Lead Pipe scratches easily and will reveal silver metallic color when scraped and will not attract a magnet
- Copper Pipe will reveal metallic "new penny" color when scraped and will not attract a magnet
- Galvanized Pipe is harder to scratch and will reveal silver or grey metallic color when scraped and will attract a magnet
- Plastic Pipe comes in many colors and will not appear metallic when scraped or attract a magnet

- Galvanized Pipe
- Plastic
